

PLAYER POSITIONS AND THEIR DUTIES

<u>TWO'S</u>

- 1. THE TWO IS A POSITIONAL PLAYER, THE ANCHORMAN OF THE TEAM.
- 2. THE TWO MUST BE CAPABLE OF PLAYING THE COMPLETE RANGE OF SHOTS.
- 3. HE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR BUILDING ON AN ADVANTAGEOUS POSITION LEFT BY THE LEADS OR TRYING TO CONVERT IF SHOTS DOWN.
- 4. THE TWO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PLAYING POSITIONAL BOWLS THAT MAY BECOME VITAL LATER IN THE END.
- 5. THE TWO MAY BE RESPONSIBLE FOR KEEPING THE SCORECARD AND SCOREBOARD.

<u>DO'S</u>

- 1. PRACTISE THE FULL RANGE OF SHOTS, DRAW, POSITIONAL DRAW BOWL, CONTROLLED WEIGHT, TRAILING THE JACK, COVER AND COUNT, WREST OUT, BLOCKER, FIRING.
- 2. ENSURE YOU ARE CONFIDENT PLAYING THESE SHOTS ON BOTH FOREHAND AND BACKHAND.
- 3. LIAISE WITH YOUR DIRECT OPPONENT TO ENSURE THE CARD AND SCOREBOARD ARE ACCURATE.

DON'TS

1. BE TEMPTED TO IGNORE THE SKIP'S INSTRUCTIONS.

SCORING YOUR OWN GAME

- 1. WHAT DID I LEARN ABOUT MY DIRECT OPPONENT FROM THE TRIAL ENDS.
- 2. HOW MANY OF MY BOWLS WERE ON TARGET, DRAWN WHEN ASKED, POSITIONED AS REQUESTED, SHORT OR IN THE DITCH.
- 3. DID I DAMAGE OUR POSITION BY UNDOING OUR LEAD'S SHOTS.
- 4. HOW MANY ENDS WERE WE AHEAD AS A RESULT OF MY BOWLS WHEN THE TWO'S HAD FINISHED BOWLING.
- 5. DID I PERSONALLY BOWL BETTER THAN MY DIRECT OPPONENT.
- 6. WAS I SUCCESSFUL AT KEEPING THE SCORECARD AND BOARD ACCURATELY UPDATED.
