Have you checked your JACKS? I was at an outdoor club recently where we discovered that we were playing with an indoor jack. YES they are different! Indoor jacks are much heavier than outdoor jacks. Please check that your jacks are the correct weight.

I have been asked to clarify the wording of the Law regarding 'draw for rinks'. This does not mean, do you want rink 4 or 5, it does mean DRAW. You can toss a coin and say 'heads for 4 and tails for 5' or you can write the rink numbers on pieces of paper and select one. Or you can put numbers on discs or something similar and draw that way. You can use playing cards! At one club I was at recently we had none of that available so we put a leaf in one hand and said 'leaf is rink 3 and no leaf is rink 4' and someone selected a hand. Which ever way you do it there must not be a 'choice' ... there must be an element of selection. Dont forget that this is a LAW of the sport and cannot be ignored, despite what some local associations think.
